Biographical Sketch

Norman Kahn, MD CPE currently serves as Convener of the Conjoint Committee on Continuing Education (CCCE), a coalition of 25 national organizations in medicine, nursing, pharmacy, dentistry and physician assistants, addressing the opioid epidemic through facilitating the continuing education of health professionals.

CCCE has advised the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on opioid policy and contributed to the FDA's "Opioid Analgesic REMS Education Blueprint for Health Care Providers Involved in the Treatment and Monitoring of Patients with Pain." CCCE is strengthened by the active participation of other agencies involved in opioid education, including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA), the US Surgeon General's Office, the President's Commission on Combating Drug Addiction and the Opioid Crisis, and the National Academy of Medicine (NAM).
