Dear Pharmacy Dean:

The ACPE Board of Directors met on June 10-12, 2026, and I would like to share some items from the meeting that may be of interest to you.

Job Placement and Gainful Employment, Disclosure of Program Outcomes, Faculty Numbers and Roster and Enrollment Data

You will be receiving ACPE's annual request to complete the Job Placement and Gainful Employment survey for the previous graduating class (i.e., Class of 2025). This request allows ACPE to meet a data-reporting requirement of the US Department of Education (USDE). This year the survey will also include additional components, a request for faculty numbers and addendum and enrollment data.

As was the case last year, the ACPE Board of Directors is monitoring faculty composition more closely. The survey asks each program to provide core faculty numbers for each department/division and provide an up-to-date faculty addendum. The faculty addendum template can be found on the ACPE website. Starting this year, the survey will also be asking for enrollment data in order to better monitor progression. The survey will be asking for your program's target enrollment, P1 enrollment for 2025 and 2026, and the number of matriculants and on-time graduates for the Class of 2026.

Annual Monitoring - NAPLEX

Just a reminder that NAPLEX pass rates are required to be posted (Policy 8.4) on your website. Please be reminded that all programs are required to post a link to the NAPLEX passing rate data on the NABP Website in addition to the most recent year's NAPLEX® results for first-time takers as reported on the NABP Website (2025 data), on-time graduation rates and a measure of student achievement for the most recent graduating class as determined by the program. ACPE staff will begin checking websites for compliance in fall 2026 as required by our CHEA recognition.


